Dear Ms. Reese:

Pursuant to Section 4 of the Natural Gas Act ("NGA") and Part 154 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("FERC" or "Commission") regulations,¹ ANR Pipeline Company ("ANR") respectfully submits an amendment to ANR's February 27, 2026 Annual Redetermination of Transporter's Use and EPC Charges filing under Docket No. RP26-586-000 ("February 27, 2026 Filing"). By the instant filing, ANR includes revised Summary Workpapers (previously filed as Appendix B in the February 27, 2026 Filing) as an amendment to this proceeding and respectfully requests that the Commission accept the amended tariff section included herein as in Appendix A-1 to become effective April 1, 2026.²

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Statement of Nature, Reasons and Basis for Filing

On February 27, 2026, in Docket No. RP26-586-000, ANR filed its Annual Redetermination of Transporter’s Use and EPC Charges. It has since come to ANR’s attention that the transactional throughput associated with the Southeast Area and Southeast Leg included in Attachment 1 of the Summary Workpapers included a discrepancy. After correcting the discrepancy, the re-calculated transactional throughput decreases the Southeast Area’s throughput from 752.2 Bcf to 707.4 Bcf and the Southeast Leg’s throughput from 871.4 Bcf to 861.8 Bcf. Consequently, the Southeast Area’s over-recovery is reduced from -0.648 Bcf to -0.492 Bcf and the Southeast Leg’s under-recovery is increased from 4.368 Bcf to 4.453 Bcf. As a result, the Transporter’s Use (%)’s in the Southeast Area (SE) and the Southeast Southern Segment (ML-2) are increasing, as shown below:

ANR is amending the February 27, 2026 Filing with revised Section 4.18, included as Appendix A-1, to become effective April 1, 2026,³ and amended Summary Workpapers previously included as Appendix B in the February 27, 2026 Filing.

Effective Date

ANR respectfully requests that the Commission accept the proposed tariff section, included as Appendix A-1, to become effective April 1, 2026.

There are no other filings before the Commission that may significantly affect the changes proposed herein.
